**Cancellation/Refund Policy:**

We realize that changes do occur and that boys and families need to make changes in their plans as time goes on. We also realize that you are making a commitment for 15 months from now and things may change. As such, the Council does have a policy for canceling your position at the 2005 Jamboree.

- 1) ALL cancellations must be made in writing to Mr. John Ashworth, 1410 East Seventh Street, Charlotte, NC 28204.
- 2) As long as there is someone on the waiting list AND we can find someone on the Waiting List to take your place, you will receive a refund of the money deposited for your son to go to Jamboree.
- 3) Written notice received by October 15, 2004 will receive a full refund.
- 4) Written notice received by June 1, 2005 will receive a refund, less a 15% administrative fee.
- 5) Notice received after June 1, 2005 will receive a refund, less a 25% administrative fee.
- 6) In the event of an accident, a refund will be issued, less 15% administrative costs, if accompanied by a doctor's verification.
- 7) In the unfortunate event of a death in the family, a full refund will be issued.
