We are very pleased that you are interested in attending the National Jamboree in 2005 at Fort A.P. Hill in Virginia. At this time we have places for 144 youth and we have 191 youth who have turned in applications. We have placed your name on the Waiting List for the Jamboree. Your current position on the Waiting List is «**Waiting_List_Number**».

Before you get too disappointed know that for the 2001 Jamboree, the Council sent 3 troops (108 youth) and had 40 boys on the waiting list in January 2001. Every boy on that waiting list had an opportunity to go to the Jamboree. We are hopeful that this will be the case in 2005.

For the 2005 Jamboree, we have 4 troops (144 youth), an extra 12 months time interval over the previous Jamboree, and still only 37 boys on the waiting list. Already we have had 7 boys decide that they would not be attending the Jamboree — and we have barely started the process.
